EXERCISE AND MOVEMENT : THE COMMON DENOMINATOR

Windsor Team Care Centre's (WTCC) wholistic model of care embraces maximizing client's mobility and movement through exercise, stretching and treatment delivered by a Registered Kinesiologist.

Kinesiology is a relatively new regulated health profession and still not widely understood for what it is and what it does to help clients. Kinesiology is the practice of assessment of human movement, performance, rehabilitation, management and functions to maintain, rehabilitate or enhance movement and performance.

Uncovering the biomechanical, physiological, neurological, and psychosocial mechanisms that drive human function.

Approximately 63% of Ontarians are affected by one or more chronic conditions. Physical activity has been shown to reduce the risk of over 25 chronic conditions including: coronary heart disease, diabetes, certain types of cancer, high blood pressure, stroke, Alzheimer's disease and certain mental health conditions.

At WTCC, Kinesiology is an important component of our services. Clinical exercise therapies are combined with education and in-scope treatment to support clients in reaching and maintaining their goals for mobility and movement with a focus on maintaining the clients' progress and wellness after they are leave the program.

As primary care providers, the following clients would benefit from treatment and support from a kinesiologist:

- Chronic Disease Management (Diabetes, Hypertension, COPD, Metabolic Syndrome, Rheumatoid Arthritis, Asthma, CHD, PAD, Parkinson's Disease, Multiple Sclerosis, Hyperlipidemia, Fatigue, Headaches)
- Mental Health (Depression, Anxiety, Stress)
- Chronic Pain (Back Pain, Osteoarthritis, Osteoporosis, Fibromyalgia)
- Weight Management (Obesity)
- > Neurological Disorders (BPPV, mTBI, TBI, Stroke, Vestibular, Ocular Motor, Epilepsy, Cerebral Palsy)

As experts in human movement and exercise science, Kinesiologist's can help clients develop, improve and sustain healthy exercise and physical activity habits to help prevent chronic disease and achieve a better state of overall wellness.
