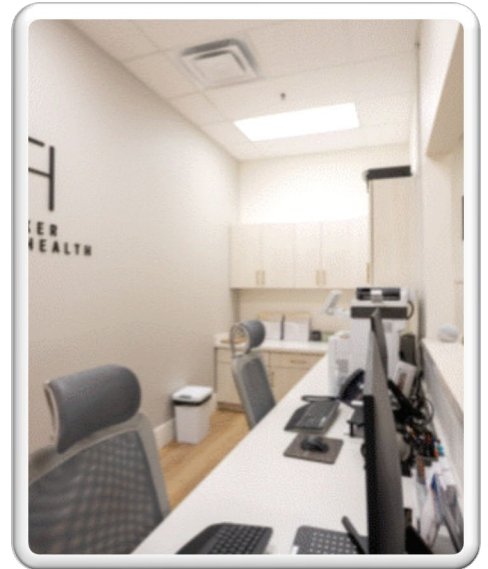


FAMILY PHYSICIAN
